CALL FOR PAPERS INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS Materials must be submitted in the Russian or English language

General (the MS Word version 6.0 or later, the format of *.rtf or *.doc, file should be named by the family name of the first author):

- ◆ page size – A4, portrait orientation;
- ◆ margins: top – 25 mm, bottom – 26 mm, left and right – 23 mm;
- ◆ font Times New Roman: main text – 11 pt; figure captions, tables – 10 pt;
- ◆ line spacing – single, no indentation before and after paragraph, indentation of the first line is 6.6 mm;
- ◆ hyphenation is disabled;
- ◆ figures and formulas are placed in the text, not "over text";
- ◆ use "point" as decimal separator;
- ◆ volume: 1 or 2 **full** pages.

Scheme of arrangement of materials:

1. Title: CAPITAL LETTERS, **bold**, centered.
2. Leave a blank line after the title.
3. Author names: centered; first name and middle name initials are written before the last name; put point after each initial, the initials are separated from each other and from the last name by a single space. Co-authors of the work are separated by a comma. Name of the speaker is underlined.
4. Name of organization: centered, the legal status of the organization (abbreviation) is not specified. If the work is done in several organizations, each organization is specified on a separate line, italicized. For Russian organizations, use capital letters only for the first word and proper nouns.
5. Leave a blank line after organization name(s).
6. Body text: alignment, justified. If necessary, highlight portions of the text with **bold**, *italic* or underline.
7. References in the text are enclosed in square brackets [1, 2...]. The list of references is given in the end of the abstract, please follow the style of **Russian Journal of Inorganic Chemistry**.
8. Between the text of the abstracts and the References with a top and bottom chipping, 6 pt is information about grants, programs, etc., within the framework of which work has been done (*italics*, alignment, justified).
