PAPER SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE 4th ALL-RUSSIAN YOUTH SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE with the international participation “ECOLOGICALLY SAFE AND RESOURCE- SAVING TECHNOLOGIES AND MATERIALS”

Materials must be submitted in Russian or English language

General properties of a document (MS Word, the format *.rtf or *.doc, file should be called by the last name of the first author):

- ◆ page size – A5, portrait orientation;
- ◆ margins: top, bottom – 20 mm, left and right - 17 mm;
- ◆ font Times New Roman: main text - 11 pt; figure captions, name and contents of tables - 10 pt;
- ◆ line spacing – single, no indentation before the paragraph and after paragraph, indentation of the first line is 5 mm;
- ◆ hyphenation is disabled;
- ◆ the figures are placed in the text, drawings, and formulas not to "over text";
- ◆ in decimal fractions use "point";
- ◆ volume: 1–2 **full** pages.

Scheme of arrangement of materials:

1. Paper title: CAPITAL LETTERS, **bold**, centered.
2. After the title an empty line.

3. The list of co-authors: **bold** type, center alignment, first name and middle name initials are written before last name, after the initials are set point, the initials are separated from each other and from the last name by a single space. Co-authors of the work are separated by a comma. **Last name of the speaker (student, graduate student, employee under 35 years of age inclusive) is underlined**, the age of the other co-authors as well as the age of the plenary speakers is not limited.

4. Name of organization: *italic*, center alignment, the legal status of the organization (abbreviation) is not specified. If the work is done in several organizations, each organization is specified in a separate line, in italics. In the names of Russian organizations only the first word and proper nouns are written with a capital letter.

5. After specifying the organizations write e-mail address of the speaker (*italic, centered*).

6. After e-mail address – empty line

7. The text of the abstract: alignment on width. If necessary, highlight portions of the text are used **bold**, *italic* and underlining.

8. References in the text are enclosed in square brackets [1, 2...]. Reference list is cited according to the rules of the **Russian Journal of Inorganic Chemistry (Zhurnal neorganicheskoy khimii)**.
